The faculty and staff offer support and personal attention, and the campus provides a friendly, caring and safe environment.

While students attend college at both campuses, <u>Goose Creek Consolidated I.S.D.</u> will provide BAER² students with opportunities for employment and experiential learning. Internships and field experiences will be available in the Baytown area for interested students.
