GO APPLYTEXAS TIPS

Step 1-Get Started

Go to www.goapplytexas.org. Select the GET STARTED button

Create a username that you can easily remember

Put in your personal email address (ex: jonesj285@gmail.com)

You will need to use an email account that you will have access to right now; a personal email is best

Create a password (must have at least 12 characters, a capital letter, a number and special character)

I suggest saving your username, email and password for this GoApplyTexas account BEFORE selecting SIGN UP

Go to your personal email account (the one you just listed) check for a GoApplyTexas verification email Click the VERIFY EMAIL link in the email

Go back to the log in page and put in the username and password that you just created and log in

Step 2-Creating your profile

Every question that has a red asterisk (*) is required. If it does not have a red asterisk (*), you can skip it.

<u>Select Start/Edit Profile</u> button in the *edit your ApplyTexas profile* box.

<u>Names Profile Page</u>: Put in your social security number if you have it. If you don't have it, you can provide it to your school(s) of choice upon admissions. Continue putting in your current legal last name and first name.

Background Page: Provide your birthday, city of birth, and country of birth. Click YES and verify that all information is correct and proceed to next page.

<u>Citizenship Page</u>: If you select YES, <u>optional questions</u> will come up regarding military status, ethnic identity, racial identity and gender. If you select NO, required questions about your country of origin and whether you have permanent residency in the US will come up.

Permanent Address Page: Provide your permanent address (address that will most likely not change and where you receive mail). Once you add the city, state, and country, you will need to select the verify address button. If your address is verified, you will receive a green confirmation to move on. If your address is not verified, you will be asked to verify the address is correct.

Physical Address Page: Leave blank if same as permanent address. If it is different, provide your physical address (where you reside)

<u>Phone Numbers Page</u>: Provide a good and active phone number to associate with your college applications. **This is YOUR phone number not** your parents. Please select whether the number you provide is a cell, home, or work.

**International country phone code is only for those students currently living outside the US, so leave this part blank.

Emergency Contact Page: Provide the last name and first name of your emergency contact. The more information that you provide, the better. NOTE: Providing such information will not have an impact on admissions.

You will need to answer whether your emergency contact has a phone number; if YES, please put the phone number in and select whether the number is cell, home or work. If NO, you can proceed to the next page but will need to list an email address.

<u>High School Information Page</u>: Provide your high school information; you can start typing the name of the school and you will have the ability to search for your school. Provide your graduation date. You can pick any day in May just make sure the year is the correct year you will graduate.

<u>College History Page</u>: If you have taken any college course work, select YES. This includes dual credit coursework while in high school as well. If you select YES, you will need to answer whether you have completed a bachelor's degree. You will also need to answer the questions related to your college coursework. If you select NO to college course question, continue to the next question.

Texas Residency Page: Provide answers for your country and state residency.

Click Done

Step 3-Applying for College

Once your profile has been completed you will be taken to the home screen. Go to the blue box on the right and select Start/Edit Applications Once you select that box, a new page with a blue box will appear and you will need to select the **START A NEW APPLICATION**
